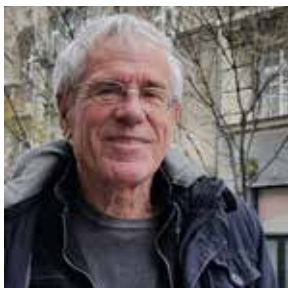

Director's bio

Želimir Žilnik has made over 50 feature and short films, exhibited internationally at film festivals including Berlin, Toronto, Rotterdam, Moscow and Oberhausen. From the late 60s, his socially engaged films in former Yugoslavia earned him accolades, but also censorship in the 70s and the 90s for his unflinching criticism of the government apparatus. His power to observe and unleash compelling narratives out of the lives of ordinary people is the common thread throughout his work.

Synopsis

In the heart of Belgrade, the Schwarz-Nikolic family resides in a quaint yet overshadowed old villa amidst the towering new buildings that besiege their neighbourhood. Bojan, the forty-year-old son still living at home, runs a desperate race against time as his beloved show dog, Sanja, is struck by a car on the street, leaving him critically injured and in need of urgent, costly surgery to ever walk again.

As Bojan scrambles to gather the necessary funds for Sanja's surgery, Luna, his determined fourteen-year-old sister, is faced with a harsh reality: her long-anticipated graduation trip to Egypt teeters on the brink of oblivion as the family's finances are redirected toward the dog's medical expenses. While Bojan and Luna wrestle with their personal challenges, their home faces an imminent threat: the looming construction of a high-rise building in their front yard, boxing them in without any natural light or a view of the sky.



Director's bio

Lee Filipovski is an award-winning film director and screenwriter, with accolades such as the Canadian Screen Award, HFPA/Golden Globes Award for Best Short Film and Nuits en Or by the Academy of Cinema Arts and Techniques César Awards. Her works have been screened at over 40 festivals around the world including Toronto International Film Festival, Telluride, Aspen Shortfest and SIFF. As a two-time recipient of the Vimeo Staff Picks badge, Lee continues to showcase her work both through online platforms and international distribution. She is a member of the Academy of Canadian Cinema and Television and an alumni of Canadian Academy Directors Program for Women presented by Netflix. Lee graduated from the School of the Image Arts at Toronto Metropolitan University (formerly Ryerson), and also holds a certificate from the Film and Television School of Performing Arts in Prague (FAMU). She received her Master's Degree in Film Directing from the Faculty of Dramatic Arts in Belgrade (FDU). She splits her time between Belgrade and Toronto.

A story about man and grief as a universal human experience that can be both isolating and unifying.



Director's bio

Maja Novaković (1987, Srebrenica, Bosnia and Herzegovina) is an Art History Master and PhD candidate studying Sergei Parajanov's poetics of heritage. She works at the Mathematical Institute of the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts. Her debut film, **Then Comes the Evening**, premiered at Visions du Reel (2019) and secured an Oscar nomination by winning at the Full Frame Documentary Festival. It received over 50 awards and was screened at 130+ festivals such as Hot Docs, Sarajevo Film Festival, Jihlava IDFF, Camerimage, Busan ISFF, Aesthetica SFF, Uppsala SFF, Big Sky FF, DokuFest, etc. and made the Cinema Eye Honors and Doc NYC Short List.

Vuk Ršumović (1975) is a Serbian director, screenwriter, playwright and university professor. He graduated in dramaturgy at the Faculty of Dramatic Arts. He spent a semester at the Jung Institute in Zurich, where he studied Jungian psychology, fairy tales, myths, and the work of Joseph Campbell. 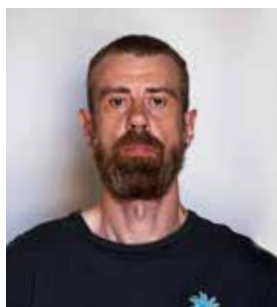

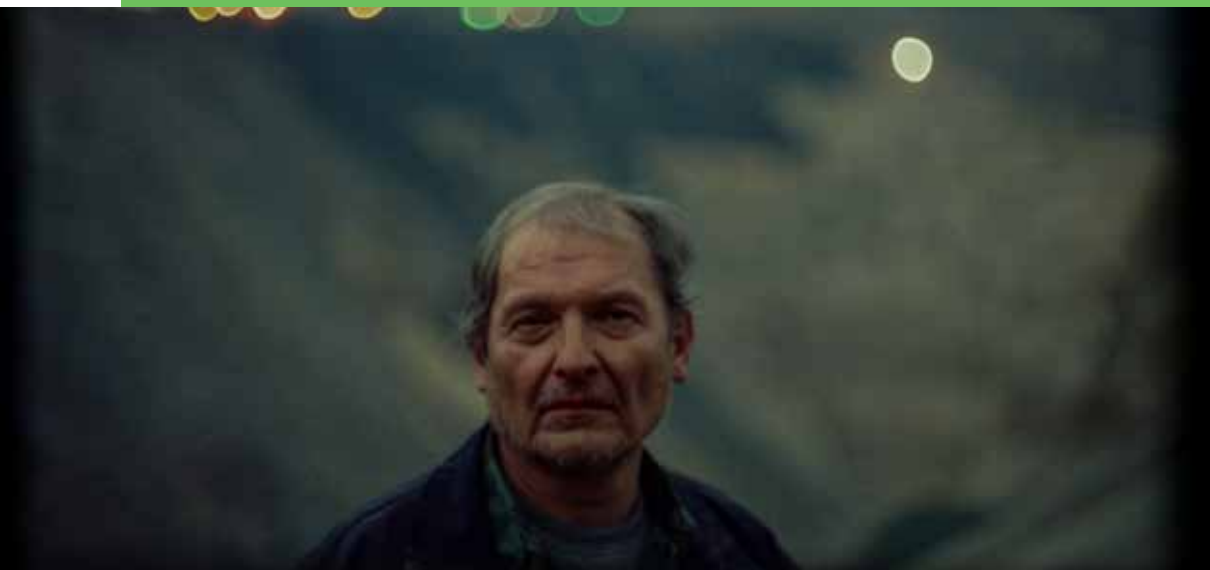


